Dear Parent,

Summer is here and plans have begun for the next school year 2009-2010! Many changes have taken place from last year with retirements, new teachers, and upgraded technology in various classrooms. Excitement is in the air as we begin the preparations for the beginning of our seventh school year at the Lawndale campus, we thank our God for the past year just completed and ask Him to continue to bless Peace Lutheran Church and School as we continue to shine the light of the Gospel in the Saginaw area.

Although it is vacation time, and we travel away from School and Church, we should not take a vacation from our Lord, but instead, "Remember the Sabbath day and keep it holy". REGISTRATION DAY - The 2009-2010 school year will begin with Registration Day at the **Lawndale Campus** on Wednesday, August 19, from 11:00 A.M. until 1:00 P.M. and from 5:00 P.M. to 7:00 P.M. Parents and students are to come during those hours to pay fees, receive information, and visit the classroom. The first day of classes is Monday, August 31.

- A. Educational (Book) Fee: Kindergarten - 8 - \$ 325.00
This fee is used to provide instructional materials for the students. It includes the use of textbooks, workbooks, library materials, art, paper charges, P.E., technology, and many other instructional items.
- B. P.T.L. - Each family will pay a fee of \$ 15.00 to the Parent Teacher League so that it can maintain its programs and service to the parents and school.
- C. Party Fund - Each child in grades K - 4 will pay \$ 5.00 to the Party Fund while grades 5 - 8 will pay \$ 8.00 for each child. This money is used to provide for the classroom parties throughout the year.
- D. Miscellaneous - Depending upon a student's needs, there may be additional costs for Bible, children's hymnal, catechism, kindergarten milk, and other miscellaneous items.

The Re-enrollment Fee/Registration Fee that you already paid will be subtracted from the total. You may need to make arrangements now to insure that these funds are available at that time. You may also make prepayment on these fees by sending them to the office during the summer.

TUITION - Tuition payments for the 2009- 2010 school year will be handled by SMART Tuition Management Services. You should have already filled out an enrollment form indicating whether you prefer automatic deduction or will send checks. **If you received a SMART form from the school office, please be certain that you return that right away. This is important if you are to remain on a 9 month payment plan.** Those of you who were previously enrolled with the SMART program are automatically re-enrolled using the same payment method as you had this past year. It is very important that you make sure that SMART has your current phone number and an e-mail address if you have internet access. Please call SMART at 1-888-868-8828 to update any information in phone numbers or addresses. If you wish to change methods, you will need to come to the office to fill out a new form. Payments are due by the tenth of the month beginning in September and continuing through May, if you are on a 9 month plan. Those who signed up to be on the 11 month plan will have payments beginning on July 10. A \$35 late fee is assessed for late payments. All payments are to be sent directly to SMART. Payments will no longer be accepted in the school office. Please allow sufficient time for payments to reach SMART so that a late fee is not assessed. Members of Peace Lutheran Church also support the school through their church offerings. Per pupil cost for the 2008 - 2009 school year was about \$ 5,000.

HOT LUNCH - A representative of Saginaw Township Community Schools hot lunch program will be here on Registration Day to accept your deposits on student hot lunch accounts. You may deposit whatever amount you would like. The account is then debited each time the student presents their card for hot lunch. This would need to be on a different check from other school tuition and fees and should be made payable to Peace Lutheran Food Service.

The number of outstanding Hot Lunch I.O.U.'s has become a problem. Please be advised that students having **three or more I.O.U.'s** will be given a peanut butter sandwich for lunch until all outstanding balances are taken care of. We are sorry to have to enforce this rule, but these debts cannot continue. Parents are able to access their student's hot lunch account balances on-line. You must first obtain a login and password by logging on to www.stcs.org then clicking on the Online Access Request Form tab under Nutrition Services.

PARENT MEETINGS - In order to accurately distribute information and materials, we will be holding parent meetings here at school in August. **Please note: these meetings are only for parents. Please do not bring children.** They are as follows:

First Grade: August 26 - 6:30 P.M.

Other teachers will hold their meetings on the evening of August 31 at 6:00 and 7:30 P.M. with a short meeting in the gym from 7:00 – 7:30 P.M. for both groups. Please be sure to attend either of those times, as important information and forms will need to be completed.

KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS/PARENTS - On Wednesday, August 26 from 6:30 - 7:30 P.M., you are invited to a casual get-together at the school to get acquainted, or re-acquainted, with one another. Come to the playground and enjoy the fellowship. In case of rain, we will meet in the cafeteria.

WELCOME ALL FIRST GRADE STUDENTS and THEIR PARENTS! - Ms. Gulliver and Mrs. Hauser invite you to a "get acquainted" gathering on Thursday, August 27 from 6:00 - 7:00 P.M. at the Peace Lutheran School playground. This is a great opportunity for parents and students to become acquainted with each other before the school year begins. If you have any questions, please call Ms. Gulliver (714-5978).

SECOND GRADE PLAYDATE - Come mix and mingle, meet new people and get re-acquainted with old friends. Meet at the playground on Wednesday, August 19 from 4:00 – 5:00 P.M.

THIRD GRADE PLAYDATE – A third grade playdate has been set for Wednesday, August 19 from 7:00 – 8:00 P.M. Come and get acquainted and re-acquainted with third graders for the coming school year. See you at the playground.

HOME VISITS - Teachers will be making home visits, especially to new families. They will be contacting those families for an appointment. If your child was enrolled previously and you would like the teacher to visit, you need to contact the teacher to set up the appointment. A list is enclosed of good times to contact each teacher. Teachers may also be visiting students at their own discretion but if you would like a visit, please be sure to let the teacher know that. The home visits are designed to better establish the parent-teacher-student relationship.

SUPPLY LIST - Enclosed with this letter is a chart of the supplies that a student will need for a particular grade. The teachers will be able to tell you more about the items needed during the parent meetings in August. We provide the list at this time to help you plan and possibly take advantage of some sales. Our school bookstore will have many of your favorite items for sale on Registration Day, and throughout the school year.

P.E. UNIFORMS - Students in grades four through eight will be required to purchase a shirt for use in physical education classes. The shirts will be available on Registration Day at a cost of \$10.00.

MEMBER SUPPORT POLICY - Enclosed is a copy of the Worship Attendance Policy. That, of course, applies to those who are members of Peace Lutheran Church. We also expect that non-member families reinforce what we teach in their homes and through faithful worship attendance.

CALENDAR - Also enclosed is a copy of the 2009-2010 school calendar. The monthly calendar will be available on registration day.

BOOK COVERING - All hard-covered textbooks are required to have a book cover on them. This can be accomplished by something as simple as a paper grocery bag. (If you purchase the stretchy cloth book covers, please use the jumbo sized covers on large books. The standard size have a tendency to distort the binding and corners of the larger textbooks.) Clear contact paper may be used on workbooks to help save wear and tear on them. However, it should not be used on textbooks because of the damage to the cover when it is removed. You may want to be assembling the materials needed over the summer.

PARENT-TEACHER LEAGUE - Please read carefully the enclosed letter from the P.T.L. On Registration Day they will be asking you to sign up to help with at least one activity. Help is also needed in making items for the Children's Christmas Bazaar.

SPORTS PHYSICALS - Sport Physicals will again be offered at a cost of \$ 12.00. Physicals are scheduled for Wednesday, August 12 from 5:30 – 7:00 P.M. If you would like to obtain a physical from your own doctor, forms are available in the school office.

LATCHKEY - All families are required to sign registration and emergency forms for the Latchkey program. This includes information such as emergency contacts (if parent cannot be reached), doctor, hospital, health insurance name and policy number. Students arriving prior to 7:50 A.M. or remaining at school after 3:20 P.M. (except for organized activities) will be required to go to the Latchkey area. Parents will be billed for the time on a monthly basis.

Before and after school care will be available to kindergarten through eighth grade Peace students. Morning Latchkey is from 7 - 8 A.M., while the afternoon program runs from 3 - 6 P.M. Fees are as follows: morning \$2 and afternoon \$3/hour or part hour thereof per child. Various information forms need to be completed annually.

PEACE DAY SCHOOL Grades 6 – 8 and parents – Orientation for Catechism will be at registration on August 19, at the Lawndale Campus. Information will be sent to you in the mail.

MEDICATION POLICY – If you expect that your student(s) may need to take any medications this year you should pick up medication control forms. One of these forms must be completed for EACH medication stored at the school This is required by state law. If your child will have ANY medications stored at Peace (daily or occasional, prescription or over-the-counter), please call the school office now and we will send you the form, so you have time to get the form completed and signed prior to the first day of school. **Additionally, all medications MUST be in their original container (prescription medications must have the pharmacy label attached). We cannot accept medications in baggies or other containers. We also will not be able to accept verbal permission to give out medications. Parents will be required to come to the school to dispense any medication for which we have no signed medication form on file.**

Teachers will have much more information regarding the beginning of the new school year at the parent meetings. Meanwhile, we pray God's blessings upon your walk with Him during this summertime. May you ever be close by His side as you are relaxed and refreshed during this period.

ATHLETIC NEWS

- The athletic department's website will continually be updated throughout the summer. The website can be accessed at the above web address. If you ever have any questions or suggestions regarding the website, please contact Mr. Neumeyer.
- Athletic physicals will be held at Peace Lutheran School on August 12, 2009 from 5:30-7:00 p.m. The cost is \$12. **All athletes must have a current physical, medical consent form, athletic contract, and hold harmless/indemnification agreement on file before they are allowed to participate in tryouts or practices.** A current physical is one that is on or after April 15 of the previous school year. The above forms are available in the school office or they may be downloaded from the athletic department's website. If you cannot attend the physical date at Peace, Valley Lutheran has scheduled physicals for August 4th from 5:30-6:30 p.m. The cost is \$12.
- **Fall Athletic Parent Meeting Change:** Rather than have our annual mandatory athletic meeting for parents in August, we will be posting the yearly orientation presentation on the athletic department's website. The presentation should be online by the beginning of August. As is indicated in the revised athletic contract, all parents of athletes are expected to view the presentation prior to their child's participation in athletics. If you have any questions or comments regarding this new process, please contact Mr. Neumeyer.
- **Fall Sports Tryouts:** Boys' soccer and girls' volleyball tryouts will be held on August 24th and 25th. Soccer tryouts for Grades 5-8 will be from 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m. Mr. Neumeyer will be coaching the team. Girls' volleyball tryouts for Grades 6-8 will be held from 4:00 p.m. – 5:30 p.m. Mrs. Amy Schrank will be coaching the "A" team and Mrs. Jenny Loree will be coaching the "B" team.
- **Seasons Switch:** The T.C.L.L. has made another minor change to the sports seasons. Beginning with the 2009-2010 season, boys' and girls' "B" basketball will be played in November and December while boys' and girls' "A" basketball will be played from January to March. All other seasons remain the same.

MEMBER WORSHIP AND TUITION POLICY

Active members of Peace Lutheran Church have the privilege of discounted tuition rates for Peace Lutheran School and Saginaw Valley Lutheran High School.

Rationale:

- A. Peace Lutheran Church contributes a significant percentage of the offerings received in worship services to the cost of operating Peace Lutheran School.
- B. Peace Lutheran Church is an association member of Valley Lutheran High School (VLHS). As such, Peace gives a “per communicant member” assessment to VLHS on a yearly basis from the offerings received in worship services. Therefore, the Member Tuition Policy outlined below applies to VLHS tuition as well.
- C. Regular participation in worship and encouragement toward Biblical principles of stewardship will continue to move members of Peace Lutheran Church to support these important Christian education opportunities.
- D. Because the contribution to Peace Lutheran School and VLHS change from year to year, you may contact the Parish and School Administrator for the financial details.

To qualify for the member tuition discount the following criteria must be met:

- A. A parent/guardian and the student must be active members of Peace Lutheran Church. To be considered an active member of Peace Lutheran Church, the parent/guardian will have completed adult confirmation classes, or his/her membership will have been transferred from another LCMS congregation. The membership is effective when it is confirmed to the Board of Elders in the pastor’s report. (Please note that the Board of Elders typically meets the fourth Monday of each month.)
- B. An active member family is defined as having one parent/guardian and an enrolled student who attends weekly (including Lent/Advent/special) worship services 50% of the weeks on a semester basis. The number of worship services in any given semester is defined by the number of Sundays that fall within the semester from the opening to the closing of the school year. Specific dates are published in the School Calendar.
- C. Children Kindergarten – Grade 5 may attend either Sunday School or a worship service; Grades six through twelve must attend worship services to meet attendance requirements. The member shall be responsible for filling out an attendance card at each worship service attended.
- D. If a member family attends less than the 50% requirement in one semester the member tuition discount will be on probation for the following semester. Families on Tuition assistance are expected to meet the 50% minimum as well. Should the family choose to neglect worship and fail to meet the requirement during the probationary semester, they will be placed on full tuition status for the following semester.
- E. Exceptions due to illness or other unavoidable circumstances may be taken to the Sr. Pastor for consideration and consultation with the Principal and Parish/School Administrator.
- F. A pastor or elder will contact the family in question before action is taken regarding member tuition status.
