## Re-enrollment

After much prayer and careful consideration the Peace Lutheran School Board has established fees for the next school year (2012-2013). The Re-enrollment Fee of **\$ 350** (which is non-refundable), equal to the Education Fee for one child, will be due with the Re-enrollment Covenant by Friday, February 17. **Only one Re-enrollment fee per family is needed at that time to secure a place for the entire family.** If there is more than one child that will be re-enrolling, appropriate fees will be assessed in August when registration takes place. The \$ 350 Re-enrollment fee will be credited against the fees that are due at that time. **Re-enrollment Covenants for each family will be sent home with the youngest student in the family on February 2.**

Enrollment for Peace Lutheran Church members currently not having students in the school will begin Monday, February 21<sup>st</sup>. Open enrollment for other new students begins on February 27<sup>th</sup>.

The operating cost of educating a child at Peace was over \$ 5,000 last year, and the Board considered this when establishing the following fees:

**Re-enrollment Fee: \$ 350 per family**  
**Educational (Book) Fee: \$ 350 per additional student in family (due in August)**
